


1. Trend of HIV/AIDS in Japan





Population of Japan and Tokyo



HIV patients in Tokyo and Japan




Trend of newly registered HIV cases in Tokyo




Newly registered AIDS cases in Tokyo (2014)

Number of HIV cases 512




HIV Prevalence in Tokyo by Transmission Category (2014)





No. of tests at public health centers in Tokyo




HIV positive rate at public health centers in Tokyo




Current situation of core AIDS hospitals in Tokyo

Medical cost and Insurance in Japan


- Medical cost for Antiretroviral thrapy(ART) is Approximately 200,000 Yen (1,800 US\$)/Month
- 70% of medical cost is covered by insurance
- We have a system for subsidizing the remained cost
- Final costs is 0~20,000 Yen (0~180 US\$)/Month
 * The payments are decided by income.


Cumulative HIV+ cases (Komagome Hospotal)


