








Bangkok AIDS Situation

Increased focus where of new infections occur with effective package of intervention







65% of new

Estimated number of new infection by route of transmission




Bangkok shares 1/3 of total new infections, 40% among MSM, SW & clients and IDU




Number of new infections (Total, MSM, SW & clients and IDU) In Bangkok compared to Thailand

Bangkok shares **31.53%** of among MSM total new infections in Thailand




Estimated number of Key Population in Bangkok 2016




Estimated number of new infection, people living with HIVand

death in Bangkok Thailand




Estimated number of new infection by Kay Population in Bangkok 2016




HIV prevalence by year: general population, Bangkok : 1991 - 2015

HIV Prevalence among MSMs by venue Bangkok, Thailand





use of condoms among male-male sex(MSM) with male regular partner




use of condoms among male sex workers(MSW)




Use of condoms among transgender women(TG)




Access to prevention information/supplies among MSM




Access to prevention information/supplies among MSW


