# HIV-TESTING OF KEY GROUPS REPRESENTATIVES IN TOMSK REGION

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#### **KEY GROUPS**

Following groups of people are at increased risk of HIV infection due to specific higher-risk behaviors.

- People who inject drugs (PID)
- Sex workers (SW)
- Men who have sex with men (MSM)

These groups are often referred to as hard-to-reach/closed populations





# ORGANIZING HIV-TESTING AND CONSULTATIONS FOR KEY GROUPS IN TOMSK REGION

- According to the regulatory documents, key groups representatives are subject to annual HIV-screening.
- Medical institutions of any kind draw blood samples when a patient comes in for medical assistance, or upon patient's initiative
- 11 federal and 4 commercial laboratories carry out HIV-screening.
- 91% of screening tests and 100% reference studies (more than 250 thousand studies per year) is carried out by Regional State-funded medical institution "Tomsk regional center for prophylactics and control of AIDS and other infectious diseases"





### CONCEPT OF HIV-TESTING AND CONSULTATIONS COVERAGE FOR KEY GROUPS

#### MEDICAL ORGANIZATIONS

Initiated by medical personnel (patient coming for medical assistance):

**ELISA** testing

Initiated by a person, including anonymous testing:
ELISA testing

NON-GOVERMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOs)

**NGO**-based low-threshold programs:

Express testing using oral swabs (OraQuick)

NGO-based low-threshold programs involving medical personnel:

Express testing using finger-stick blood samples.

If result is HIV+, client is referred to AIDS Center to verify the diagnosis






## MAIN PRINCIPLES OF HIV-TESTING AND CONSULTATIONS FOR KEY GROUPS IN TOMSK REGION

- Accessibility: test is available in any medical organization, including anonymous option, no documents required
- Free of charge: HIV-testing is free for citizens of Russia
- Voluntary: screening is carried out voluntarily after filling out informed consent form
- Mandatory pre-testing and post-testing consultations
- Confidentiality compliance



#### PROBLEMS OF HIV-TESTING OF KEY GROUPS REPRESENTATIVES

- Active drug use, chaotic lifestyle, substandard quality of life.
- Social exclusion and lack of motivation to support good health
- Unwillingness of key group representatives to disclose their status, fear to be stigmatized
- Closed nature of key groups communities impedes awareness-building efforts and prophylactic work
- Absence of outreach personnel and social workers in governmental organizations, which lowers the efficiency of work of informing key groups representatives and motivating them for screening







## MEASURES TO EXPAND COVERAGE OF HIV-TESTING AND CONSULTATIONS FOR KEY GROUPS IN TOMSK REGION

- Using mass-media to inform about necessity of testing and opportunities of HIV-screening
- Linkage between testing for HIV and providing treatment
- Placing information on websites of medical institutions
- Holding information campaigns on HIV problems involving key groups representatives
- Providing easy access to testing and convenience of HIV-testing procedures
- Collaboration with NGOs to inform key groups representatives and motivate them to undergo screening

# MAIN OPERATIONAL PRINCIPLES USED BY NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS FOR HIV-TESTING AND CONSULTATIONS OF KEY GROUPS

#### **Reducing barriers:**

- Accessible location, anonymity, services rendered without id;
- Approaching the target group;
- Nondiscriminatory attitude towards the key groups representatives

#### Feasibility and incremental increase of complexity of activities:

- Making contact and creating trust relationships with clients,
- Solving associated first-order problems,
- Starting with simpler activities (conversations, peer-to-peer consultations)





### FACTORS OF EFFECTIVE WORK ON TESTING AND CONSULTATIONS FOR KEY GROUPS REPRESENTATIVES

- Services are rendered in locations which are comfortable for the target audience: as a part of mobile centers tours, outreach work, or hosted by non-governmental organizations that gained public trust
- Close and fruitful collaboration between non-governmental organization and AIDScenter
- Participation of peer-to-peer consultants
- Additional motivation for the clients (food and hygienic packages, help to solve first-order problems etc.)





#### EXPRESS TESTING LOCATIONS

- Outreach work
- Mobile center for testing and consultations
- Low-threshold center
