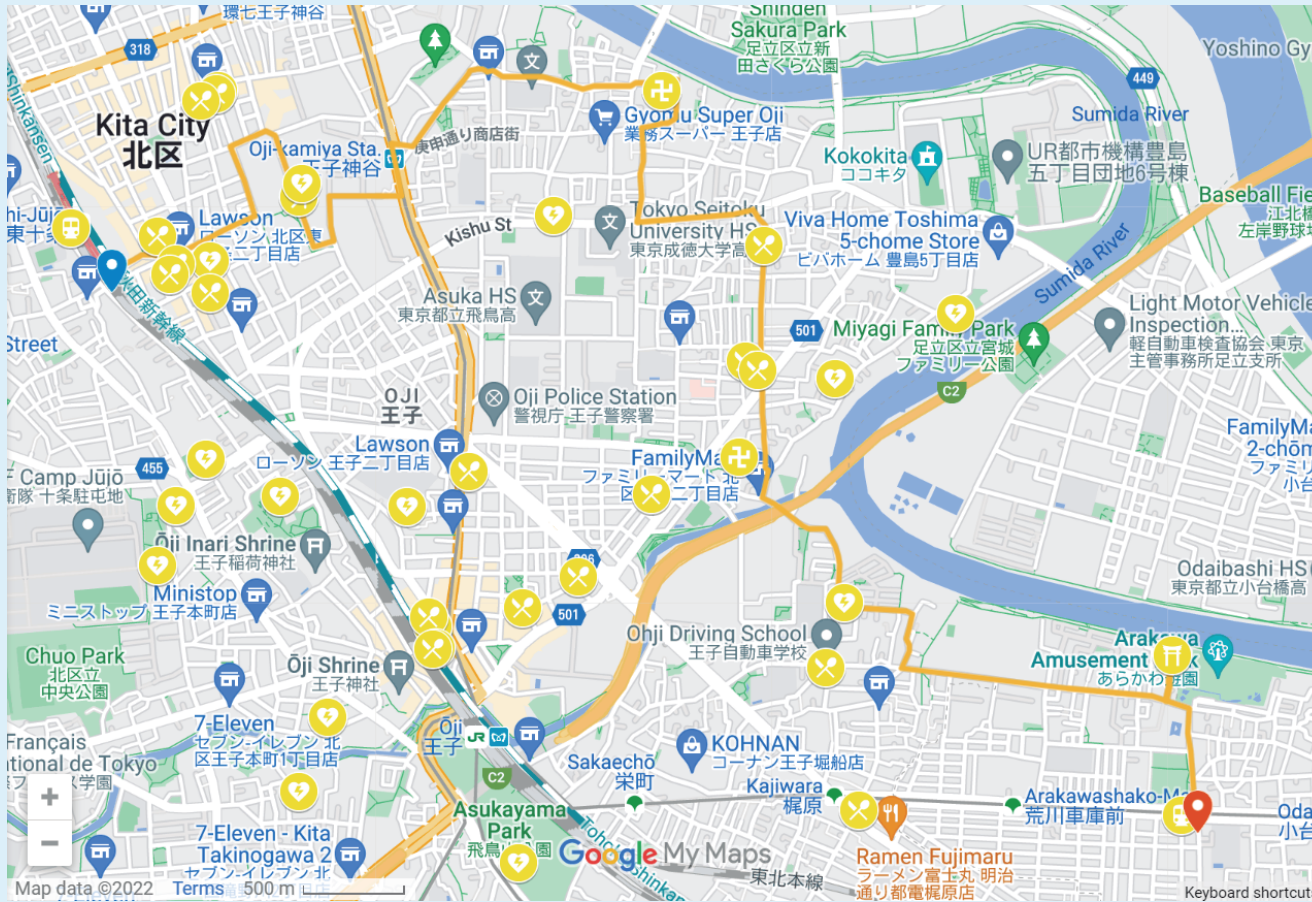

🏠 Ikigai Activity Center KIRARIA Kita



In order for the elderly to live long and healthy, this center supports not only health promotion, but also "ikigai-zukuri," which leads to "employment" and "social participation" for the elderly.

🏯 Seikoji temple



The principal image, a statue of Fudo myo-o, is one of the Seven Toshima Buddhas that Kiyomitsu Toshima had Gyoki carve. A statue of Kiyomitsu and other items are housed in the main hall.

🏯 Saifukuji temple



Known as the first temple of the Six Amitabhas. Six monuments that memorialize six members of the Shogitai, and the graves of horses, are also there on the grounds.

🏯 Funakata shrine



Called “Juniso” until it was renamed in 1879, it is believed to be related to the Kishu Kumano Gongen.

🚶 The Toden streetcar line



The Toden Arakawa Line is the only streetcar line in Tokyo, and among the few remaining in Japan. It is used by over 45,000 people daily on average, and has a lot of loyal fans.
