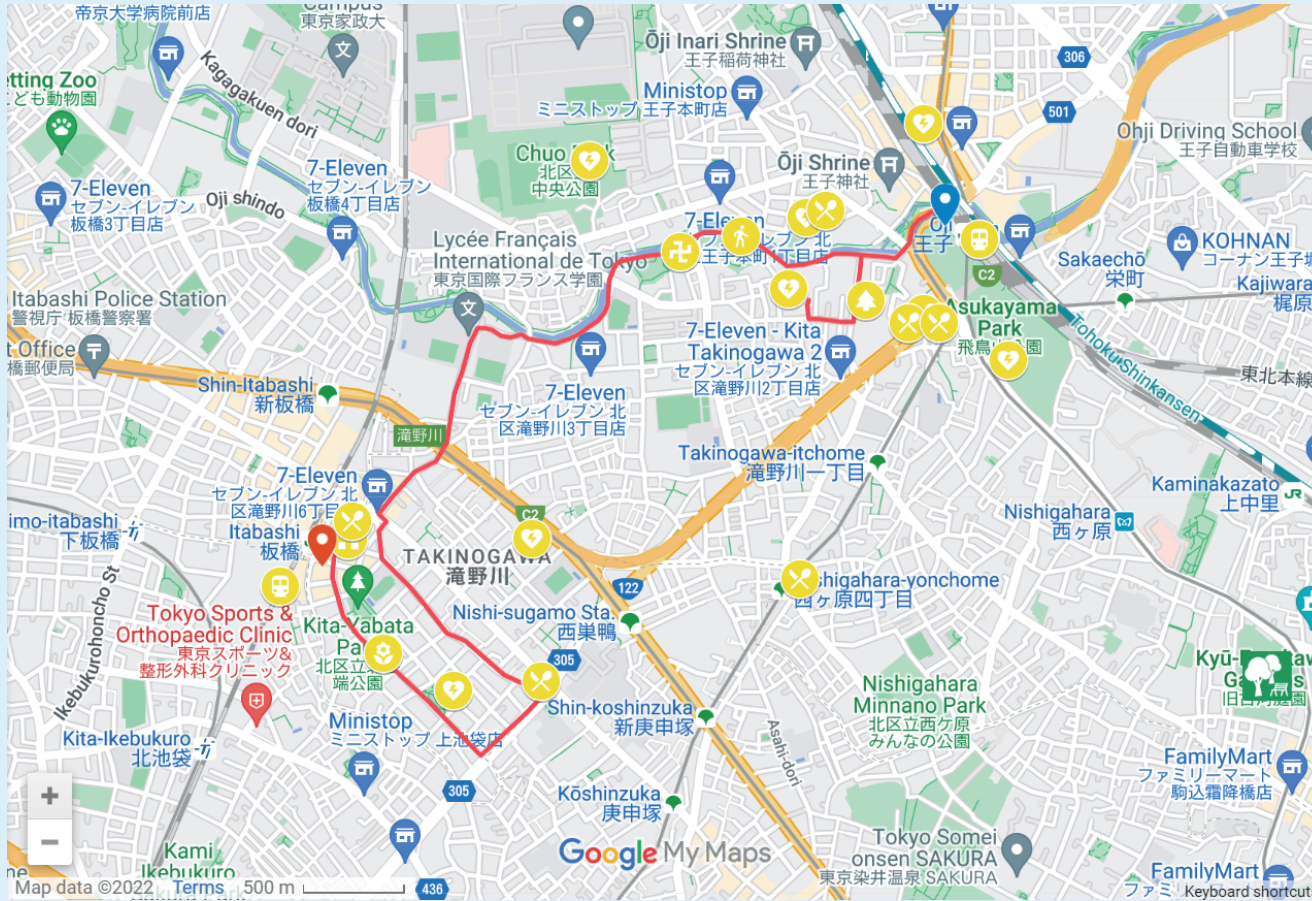


Route F: Oji ~ Itabashi

🌳 Park in the Site of the National Research Institute of Brewing Established by the Former Ministry of Finance



The brewery laboratory was a facility for the development of brewed beverage manufacturing technology and the appraisal of commercial sake, but in 1995 it relocated to Hiroshima, and the site was developed into a park.

🏠 Shakujii River and Pedestrian Walkway



There are beautiful walking paths on both banks of the Shakujii River that stretches from Otonashi-Shinsui Park to Otonashi Kunugi Green, providing the optimal walking course regardless of the season.

Kongoji temple (Momijidera temple)



Because maple trees planted in the Shakujii River basin that stretches from Otonashi-Shinsui Park to Otonashi Kunugi Green made it a place of interest, it acquired the nickname "Momiji-dera" ("Maple Temple").



Cherry Tree-Lined Yabata-Dori (Ave.) around Takenogawa 7-chome



Approximately 100 cherry trees line both sides of the street that runs for about 600 meters. In spring, a very beautiful cherry blossom arch is formed.



Memorial Tower to Isami Kondo and Shinsengumi Samurai



The location of the death of Isami Kondo, one of the key players in the last days of the Tokugawa Shogunate. It was built by Shinpachi Nagakura, a former Shinsengumi warrior, for burial with Toshizo Hijikata, who died in battle.
